2024/25 SEASON CALENDAR

Based on feedback from member clubs, the 2024/25 Season Calendar has been amended so that there are NO double header Open Pennant weekend matches.

An extra date has also been added to include an expanded finals series, to allow more sides to qualify for Open Pennant finals.

2024/25 OPEN PENNANTS

As per BNSW 2024/25 COP, clubs have been allocated grades for 2024/25 Open Pennant based on performance from 2023/24 season.

All Zone Grade Winners have been promoted whilst all sides who finished last in their respective grades have been relegated, irrespective if that club has a side in the grade higher/lower.

Please note that clubs will still have the opportunity to enter in more/less sides, however if they would like to have their grades re-allocated, they must comply with ALL facets of 2024/25 COP and then it MAY be permissible.

WOMENS PENNANT:

As MSEB has multiple former Women's Districts joining that each had their own practices and process in regard to pennant green fees and catering and in order to maintain consistency across all pennant competitions, the MSEB Management Committee has advised that the following process MUST be adopted:

It is up to individual clubs to determine what green fee they charge their own players (this fee can be for both home & away matches) however green fees MUST NOT be charged to visiting club's players/managers.

It is also recommended that the home club supply a light snack for ALL home & away players & managers after each pennant match.

This will bring into line a consistent approach to all of our pennant competitions.

For example:

At Club A there is a green fee for their own players of \$10 Green Fee for all Pennant matches (home & away) and the club supplies a light snack for all players & managers (home & visiting) after each home game.

The fees raised by charging for both home & away matches should cover the costs for supplying a light snack after home games throughout the season.

At Club B there is a green fee for their own players of \$15 Green Fee for Pennant matches at HOME ONLY and the club supplies a light snack for all players & managers (home & visiting) after each home game.

The fees raised by charging for home matches should cover the costs for supplying a light snack after home games throughout the season.
